

Louise Schwerin

Nov. 11, 1895 - May 11, 1985

Monticello – Mrs. Elmer (Louise S.) Schwerin, 89, 516 S. Main St., Monticello, died at 1:25 am. Saturday, May 11, 1985, in St. Clare Hospital where she was a patient since May 4. She had been in failing health for the past year.

She was born Nov. 11, 1895, on the Schultz homestead farm in Mount Pleasant Township, Green County, the daughter of August and Barbara (Freitag) Schultz. She attended Silver and Attica rural schools.

She was married to Elmer F. Schwerin June 16, 1914, in Monticello, by the late Rev. Albert Muehlmeier. They farmed in Mount Pleasant Township near Attica until retiring to Monticello in 1945.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. W.L. (Wilma) Zimmerman of Monticello; a brother, Emil Schultz of Evansville; and one grandson.

She was preceded in death by her husband Sept. 26, 1971, a son, Vaughn, May 31, 1917, and a brother, William, April 19, 1972.

Mrs. Schwerin was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and the Royal Neighbors Lodge of Albany.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday in Zwingli United Church of Christ. The Rev. Charles G. Workman, retired pastor, will officiate in place of the Rev. Don Nelson, interim pastor. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
