


DAVID E. SEEHOLZER

David E. Seeholzer, age 74, Monticello, died Thursday, February 9, 2006 at the Monroe Clinic Hospital. Dave was born March 9, 1931 in Freeport, IL, the son of Ernest and Goldie (Leiser) Seeholzer. He graduated from high school in Smithfield, Utah and completed a cheesemaking short course at U.W. Madison. He married Bonnie Jessop on June 7, 1952 in Utah. Dave worked as a cheesemaker for 25 years at the Silver-Lewis CO-OP where he won several cheesemaking awards. He also worked for 20 years at Fish Building Supply, Monroe (now U.B.C.) until retiring in 2005. Dave was actively involved in the Village of Monticello where he was a Past President of the Village Board, Past President of the Monticello School Board, and also was a member of C.E.S.A. He served in the Wisconsin National Guard, was a member of the Green County Ag Chest and Wisconsin State Cheesemakers Assoc., served as Cheese Days King, and was an avid sportsman, excelling in slow pitch and bowling.



Survivors include his wife, Bonnie Seeholzer, Monticello; a daughter, Cynthia (Rick) Allen, Sun Prairie; a son, Stephen (Kris) Seeholzer, Green Bay; and five grandchildren, Jeffrey, Bryan and AnnMarie Wilson, and Kendra and Brooke Seeholzer.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
