Stephen L. Senn, Aurora, Colorado, died December 13, 1993, at home. He was 45.

Graveside services were held on Sunday, December 19, at Highland Cemetery, Monticello. The Rev. Erwin Pegel officiated and a memorial color guard was presented by Chapter 3 of the Wisconsin Vietnam Veterans Organization. A luncheon followed at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

He was born November 7, 1948, in Monroe. He served in the Army as a medic during the Vietnam War. He was a recent graduate of Metropolitan State College of Denver with a degree in health care management. He was employed for over 12 years. by the National Jewish Center for Immunological and Respiratory Medicine as an assistant supervisor of the Pulmonary Physiology Unit and lead technician of the Bronchoscopy Exercise Lab. An avid fisherman and hunter, he also enjoyed golf, tennis and softball.
