SUDDEN TAKING AWAY

Mrs. Susanna Stauffacher Succumbs to the Inevitable After Brief Illness

Mrs. Susanna Stauffacher passed away at her home in this village at 1 o'clock Saturday morning after an illness of only a few days duration. She was taken ill about ten days before her death with an attack of double pneumonia, from which she seemed to be recovering nicely, until a short time before the end came, when heart trouble set in and resulted in her sudden taking away, Being entirely unexpected, the sorrowful news came with crushing force to relatives and friends alike, and expressions of deepest regret are heard on every hand.

She was the daughter of Johann Peter Bähler and Elsbeth Disch from Elm.

The deceased was in her seventy-first year and had resided in this vicinity for a great many years. The funeral was held today from the house at 12 o'clock and from the German Reformed church at 1 p. m., Rev. Carl Heyl officiating. The remains were taken to New Glarus for interment.
