Deanne Stenbrotten Dies: Services Held
4-Month-Old Child Expires At Home Thursday of Brief Illness

Suffering from a malignant illness, Deanne Kay, 4-month-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Stenbrotten, route 2, Monroe, passed away at 3 o'clock Thursday morning, June 26, at the home of her parents, about four miles south of Monticello.
