

## **Marion M. Swann**

**May 3, 1897 - Dec. 11, 1978**

Funeral services will be held Thursday for Marion Swann, 81, Route 1, Albany, who died at 6:50 p.m. Monday, Dec. 11, in St. Clare Hospital following a brief illness.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Thursday in Gohlke's Sharer Funeral Home, Albany, the Rev. Dan Mitchell, of the Albany United Methodist Church, officiating. Interment will be in the Attica Cemetery.

Visitation will be from 5 to 8 p.m. today in the funeral home where Masonic services will be conducted at 7:30.

Marion Swann was born May 3, 1897, in Brooklyn Township, the son of Ralph and Myrta Bartlett Swann. His marriage to the former Ida Kubly took place Nov. 6, 1913, in Monticello. The couple had since farmed in the Attica area.
