

Reinhart Theiler

June 23, 1902 - June 27, 1978

Reinhart J. Theiler, 76, Madison, died Tuesday, June 27, 1978 in St. Clare Hospital, Monroe, where he had been a patient since June 13.

He was born on the family homestead in Washington Township, Green County, on June 23, 1902, the son of John H. and Rosina (Blumer) Theiler.

He was a 1920 graduate of Monroe High School and was married to the former Weltha Babler on July 10, 1923, in Monroe. They lived in Richland Center for several years while he operated the Orpheum Theater in Madison. In 1928 they moved to Madison, where he worked for the former Simon Bros. wholesalers, and later as a car salesman.

Funeral services were held Friday, June 30 at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Rev. Jon C. Schultz officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery.

Survivors include his wife; three sisters, Mrs. Lena Pfund, Monroe; Mrs. William Press, Beloit and Mrs. Edna Bodemier, Monroe.
