

## **Russell L. “Rusty” Truttmann**

MONTICELLO — Russell L. “Rusty” Truttmann, 24, Monticello, died Saturday, Feb. 24, 1996.

He was born Sept. 30, 1971 in Monroe, the son of Dennis and Alberta (Disch) Truttmann. He was a 1989 graduate of Monticello High School and a 1991 graduate of Universal Technical Institute, Chicago.
