

**Walter R. Tryon**  
**Nov. 21, 1905 - Dec.18, 1986**

Walter R. Tryon, 81, 422 Washington St., Monticello, died Thursday, Dec. 18, 1986 at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe. He was born Nov. 21, 1905 at Windham, Ohio, the son of Alfred and Sherena (Resch) Tryon. He graduated from Windham High School in 1927. He married Elva Babler Dec. 31, 1937 in the Reformed Church parsonage, Monticello.

Mr. Tryon farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township, rural Monticello until he went into semi-retirement in 1964. He and his wife moved to Monticello in 1979, He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and its adult fellowship.
