Rites Held Monday P. M. for Mrs. Pearl Vine, Aged 54 Years

Funeral services for Mrs. Percis M. Vine, 54 years of age, who was found dead at her residence in Monroe last Thursday afternoon, were held at 2 Monday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Ernest Brunner, Murl F. Sweet, Cecil Holloway, Monroe, Matt Bissig, Albert Crouch and Josiah Crouch, Jr.

Coroner Herman A. Stuessy ruled the death suicide by poisoning. She was reported to have been despondent recently.

The daughter of George and Weston Alderman Haefner, she was born in Vernon county on May 30, 1898. She attended Monroe county rural schools and was married Dec. 24, 1918, in Clark county to LeRoy Vine. They farmed in Clark county until 1929. They had lived in the Green county area since.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Willis Disch, Monticello; two brothers, John Haefner, Olympia Wash., and Peter, Monticello; a sister, Mrs William Purdy, Sparta, and three grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and a brother, Evan.
