

## **Emil G. Voegeli**

NEW GLARUS — Emil G. Voegeli, 97, a former Monticello Village Board member, died Friday, Nov. 24, 1989, at the New Glarus Home where he had lived since 1975.

He was born Nov. 8, 1892, in Washington Township, Green County, the son of Baltz and Rosa (Figi) Voegeli and attended Washington Township schools and technical school in Milwaukee.

He married Christie Lemon Sept. 25, 1913, in Monticello. He farmed in Washington Township and then operated Voegeli Tire and Service in Monticello until his retirement in 1948.

Mr. Voegeli was a member of the Monticello Village Board for over 25 years, serving as village president for the 1959-1961 term. He was also a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello, a New Glarus Masonic Lodge member for over 65 years, a charter member of the Monticello Community Club and a member emeritus of the Monticello Fire Department.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Robert D. (Marian) Taylor of Hilton Head Island, SC, and Mrs. W. R. (Phyllis) Koch of Madison; seven grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, June 21, 1975; a son, Paul E., Nov. 13, 1980; four brothers, John in 1954, Alfred in 1970, Edward in 1977 and Leon A. July 11, 1989; and one sister, Alice, in childhood.

Funeral services are 11 am. Monday at Zwingli United Church of Christ with the Rev. Erwin H. Pegel, pastor of the church, officiating. Burial is in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
