

**Joe J. Voegeli**  
**July 1, 1889 - April 18, 1968**  
**Joe J. Voegeli Stricken at 78**

Joe J. Voegeli, 78, Oakwood Lutheran Home, 6401 Mineral Point Road, Madison, formerly of Monticello, died this morning, April 18, 1968, at 9:45 at the University Hospital, Madison.

Mr. Voegeli suffered a stroke on April 8 and had been hospitalized since that time.

He was born July 1, 1889 in Washington Township on the Voegeli homestead farm, located between New Glarus and Monticello on Highway 69.

His parents were Jacob and (Verena Freitag) Voegeli.

He attended Voegeli rural school and was married Sept. 21, 1911, at Monticello, to Rose Anna Schilt.

A retired hardware dealer, he had left active business in 1961 after 50 years. He was a well-known Monticello resident. Since 1964, he had made his home at the Oakwood Lutheran home in Madison.

He is survived by one son, Donald J. Voegeli, Madison, an associate professor in the School of Music at the University of Wisconsin; one brother, Jacob Voegeli, Monticello; four grandchildren, Thomas, Kim, Jim and Julie Voegeli, all of Madison.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, on Nov. 18, 1963; three brothers, Walter and Fred, twins, of Monticello, John, of Lodi, and two sisters, Mrs. Henry (Fannie) Duerst, of Monticello, and Mrs. Fred (Barbara) Wild, of Belleville, and two grandchildren, Donna Jean Voegeli, in 1949, and Bobbie Voegeli, in 1953.

Mr. Voegeli was a member of the Zwingli Church in Monticello, the Monticello Masonic Lodge, New Glarus Chapter, Madison Consistory, Zor Temple Shrine and the Eastern Star. He was a former director of the Wisco Hardware Co., Madison.
