

## **Mrs. Lillian Voegeli, Age 78, Succumbs; Services Wednesday**

**Aug. 5, 1895 - Dec. 26, 1971**

Funeral services for Mrs. Jacob A. Voegeli, 76 years of age, who died at 3:45 Sunday morning in her home here after a long illness, were held. at 1:30 Wednesday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here

The Rev Charles G. Workman, church pastor, officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers; were Wilbert J. Dick and Frederick S. Voegeli Monticello; Karl Wild, Belleville; Richard W. Voegeli, New Glarus; John J. Voegeli, Arlington, and Donald J. Voegeli, Madison.

Mrs. Voegeli had suffered from an asthmatic condition for imany years.

The former Lillian Weiss was born in New Glarus on Aug. 5, 1895. On Feb. 21, 1918, she was united in marriage to Jacob A. Voegeli and the couple lived on the Voegeli farm, northwest of Monticello, until moving to the village in April, 1954.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ and its Ladies Aid Society, and was a member of the Amstutz-Marty American Legion Post Auxiliary.

Mr. and Mrs. Voegeli observed their 50th wedding anniversary on Feb. 21, 1968.
