F. E. Wiesenberg, Aged 66, Expires

Former Washington Twp. Native Passes Away In Home

Funeral services for Ferdinand Ernest Wiesenberg, 66 years of age, a Washington township native, who passed away in his home in Monroe at about 4:30 Thursday morning, were held at 2 Saturday afternoon in the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home.

Rev. Paul C. Kehle, pastor of St. John's Evangelical church, Monroe, officiated. Interment was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.

Born in Washington

Mr. Wiesenberg was a native of Washington township, having been born Oct. 26, 1872, the son of Christian and Wilhelmina Coplien Wiesenberg. On June 29, 1905, he was united in marriage to Emma Yaussi, the ceremony having been conducted in Monroe by the late Rev. Schuh, of St. John's Evangelical church. The couple made their home on a farm in Washington township until 25 years ago when they moved to Monroe to reside, having sold their farm to Robt. Holcomb, present owner.

Mr. Wiesenberg was a confirmed member of the Washington Reformed church and later attended St. John's church, Monroe.

At one time Mr. Wiesenberg was a candidate for Green county sheriff.

Surviving besides the widow are three brothers, Herman, Monroe, and John and Otto, Evansville; and nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister, one brother, two half-brothers and one half-sister.
