Mrs. Wilbert (Hilda) Wirth, 54, Monroe, died Wednesday evening, Dec. 8, 1982, in University Hospitals, Madison, following a lingering illness.

She was born in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, on June 15, 1928, the daughter of John and Anna Gerber Saxer. Her marriage to Wilbert Wirth took place on Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, on April 5, 1945. They farmed in Exeter, Clarno and Jefferson Townships before moving to Monroe in 1976.
