Mrs. Lester Witt, Mt. Pleasant, Dies
Conduct Final Services for Native of Jefferson Township

Funeral services for Mrs. Lester Witt, 27 years of age, Mt. Pleasant township, who passed away at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. W. Chambers, Jefferson township, at about 6 o'clock Thursday morning following an illness which had its inception five months ago, were conducted at 1:30 Saturday afternoon for the family in the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home, Monroe, and at 2 in the Grace Lutheran church.

Rev. C. R. Lowe, church pastor, and Rev. C. H. Walter, Chicago, officiated. Interment was in the Dutch Hollow cemetery.

Mrs. Witt first became ill about five months ago and was a patient in Mercy hospital, Janesville for nearly two months. Medical aid was of no assistance in her case and on May 1 she was taken to the home of her parents. Her untimely death was attributed to bacterial endocarditis, an affliction for which medical authorities have found no cure.

Marie Chambers was born in Jefferson, township April 4, 1911. She attended the rural school in her district and was graduated from the Monroe high school with the class of 1928. She was united in marriage to Lester Witt Feb. 5, 1935, the ceremony being performed by Rev. C. H. Walter, former pastor of Grace Lutheran church.

Surviving besides the bereaved husband are one son, Paul, aged a year and a half, one sister, Miss Rhea Chambers, at home, her parents, and one brother, Evan Chambers, Monroe. One daughter died in, infancy.
