Nov. 9, 1876 - Aug 28, 1944
Life Resident of County Is Called

Mrs. Matt B. Wittenwyler, 67, lifelong resident of Green county, died at 8:30 last night in her home in the village, following a 4-day illness. She had been in poor health several years.

The daughter of Jacob and Rosina Hefty Becker, Marie Becker was born Nov. 9, 1876, in Green county, attending local rural schools. Her marriage to Matt B. Wittenwyler was solemnized Nov. 1, 1894, in New Glarus, and they lived in Washington township 10 years, moving in 1904 to a farm nearer Monticello and to the village two years ago.

Surviving are the widower; two sons, Jacob, Monticello, and Harvey, Oconomowoc; six daughters, Mrs. John E. Timm, Monroe, Mrs. Melvin Blumer, Mrs. Albert Gempeler, Mrs. John C. Elmer and Mrs. Edwin Abbott, Monticello, and Mrs. Claude Wallace, Nora, Ill.; nine grandchildren, of whom one, Cloyance Zimmerman, is with the air corps in England; one brother, Jacob Becker, Juda; and two sisters, Mrs. Henry B. Hefty, New Glarus, and Mrs. Jacob B. Hoesly, Belleville. Her parents, two sons and an infant daughter are deceased.

Last rites will be conducted at 1:30 Thursday afternoon in the Voegeli funeral home, for the family and relatives, and at 2 in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, of which she was a member, Rev. A. R. Achtemeier will officiate and burial is to be in Highland cemetery.
