

Matt H. Wittenwyler
Dec. 7, 1884 - June 27, 1973

Matt H. Wittenwyler, 88, Monticello, died at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 27, in the Monroe Manor Nursing Home where he had been admitted the day before from St. Clare Hospital. He had entered the hospital June 6 and had been in failing health since 1969 when he suffered a stroke.

He was born on a farm in Washington Township, Green County, Dec. 7, 1884, the son of John and Anna Voegeli Wittenwyler. He attended Voegeli Rural School. On Feb. 2 1908, he and the former Anna Kubly were married in Monticello by the late Rev. Carl Hyle.

After their marriage, they farmed in Washington Township for two years, and in 1910 moved to Mt. Pleasant Township where they farmed for 38 years, retiring to Monticello in 1947, They had observed their 65th wedding anniversary on Feb. 20 of this year. He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ of Monticello.

Surviving are his widow, Anna; a son, Clarence M., Monticello; a daughter, Mrs. Bernie (Mary Ann) Wilde, New Glarus; a brother, Walter H., Monticello; a sister, Mrs. Bertha Keller, Monticello; four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his father in 1941, his mother in 1946, two sisters, Mrs. Hulda Hancock, in 1964 and Mrs. Rose Cotherman in 1971, and a brother, John, in 1972.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Saturday, June 30, in the Zwingli Church with Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Friends may call after 5 p.m. Friday in the Memorial Lounge of the church and after 11 a.m. Saturday in the church sanctuary. Voegeli Funeral Service, Monticello, was in charge of arrangements.
