Mrs. Zentner Stricken at 76

MONTICELLO —Services for Mrs. Lillian Zentner, 76, who died yesterday in St. Clare hospital, are tentatively set for Tuesday afternoon. Friends may call at the Voegeli funeral home after 2 p.m. Monday.

Mrs. Zentner, longtime Monticello resident, had been ill a longtime. She was first hospitalized on April 24, 1960. Since that time she had been either at the Hilltop nursing home in South Wayne or at St. Clare.

She was the former Lillian Hageman, born Aug. 25, 1886, in Glenview, Minn., the daughter of Ludwig and Louise Gruebe Hageman. She came to Monticello as a small child. On Nov. 28, 1905, she was married here in Zwingli church to Dick L. Zentner by the late Rev. Karl Heil.

Her husband, who died Aug. 30, 1959, was a former Monticello businessman, farmer and substitute mail carrier. Mrs. Zentner was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. S. W. Thomas, Minneapolis, and two grandchildren, Jane and Jim Thomas. Two sisters and a brother preceded her in death.
