

Dean. R. Zimmerman
July 18, 1928 - June 10, 1986

Dean. R. Zimmerman, 57, 124 E. Park Ave., Monticello, died Tuesday, June 10, 1986, at St. Clare Hospital.

Born in Madison July 18, 1928, he was the son of Marvin R. and Elma L. (Remy) Zimmerman.

A 1946 graduate of Monticello High School, he attended Madison Area Technical College.

Mr. Zimmerman served two periods with the U.S. Marine Corps, entering the first time Sept. 26, 1946, in Milwaukee. He was a sergeant during this period with a military specialty of amphibian tractor mechanic. He was discharged Sept. 17, 1948, in Great Lakes, Ill. He entered the Marine Corps again Oct. 5, 1950, in Monticello and served as a staff sergeant, headquartered with the Eighth Engineer Battalion. He was discharged Nov. 5, 1951, in Camp LeJeune, N.C.

On Sept. 6, 1952, he married the former Margaret B. Oberholzer in Belleville.

A lifelong Monticello resident, Mr. Zimmerman was a master plumber and owner of Zimmerman Plumbing and Heating.

He was a member of St. Mary of Lourdes Church, Belleville; the Amstutz-Marty Post 256 American Legion, the Community Club and Monticello Professional and Business Association. Mr. Zimmerman was also a charter member of the Edelweiss Country Club, New Glarus.

After being a member of the Monticello Fire Department for 40 years and serving as fire chief for several years, he was made an honorary member of the department.

Survivors include his wife Margaret, one daughter, Mrs. Michael (Jean Marie) Zeigle, Tomah; and three grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his mother Jan. 4, 1964, and father, April 15, 1970.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at St. Mary of Lourdes Church, Belleville, with the Rev. Kenneth Klink officiating. Following cremation a private burial will be held at a later date at the Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
