

**MARY ANN ZIMMERMAN**  
**August 26, 1934 - October 2, 2012**

Mary Ann Zimmerman, age 78 of Sun Prairie, formerly of Monticello, died Tuesday, October 2, 2012 at Willows Nursing Home, Sun Prairie.

Mary Ann was born August 26, 1934 in Marshfield, WI, the daughter of Charles and Elizabeth (Jenneman) Schmitz. She spent her early years growing up at the U.W. experiment station where her father worked as head herdsman. Mary Ann graduated from Monroe High School in 1952 and married Dwight H.
