

Dean C. Zurbuchen
June 19, 1950 - October 5, 1979

Dean C. Zurbuchen, 29, 204 Valerie Lane in Monona, died Friday, Oct. 5, from injuries suffered in an automobile accident that evening on Monona Drive.

He was born in Monroe, on June 19, 1950, the son of Theophil J. and Merlee Pickett Zurbuchen. He was a 1968 graduate of Monticello High School and of the UW-Platteville, class of 1973. He had also traveled and studied in Europe. He was a Monona resident since 1977. He was employed by the Ganser Home Improvement Company.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Oct. 9, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where he was a confirmed member. Rev. Charles Workman officiated and burial was in Swiss Church Cemetery, New Glarus.

Survivors include one brother and sister-in-law, Zane and Mary Zurbuchen, Monticello and several aunts, uncles and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, one in infancy in 1931 and Willard, in 1949.
