

**Rose Zwickey**  
**December 16, 1863 - December 15, 1953**

**Mrs. Rose Zwickey Dies of Injuries**

Funeral services for Mrs. Rose Zwickey, 89 years of age, a native of Monticello, who had resided in Albany for many years, who died at 8:30 p. m. on Wednesday night of last week from injuries received in an automobile accident, were held Friday afternoon in the Sharer funeral home, Albany.

Mrs. Zwickey, who would have observed her 90th birthday last Thursday, was critically injured as a result of a traffic accident on highway 59, 5 miles northeast of Monroe.

Earl Zwickey, Albany, her son and driver of the car, received severe head cuts and bruises. The son's wife, a passenger in the car, suffered from bruises and shock.

The car apparently skidded on ice and went out of control, hit a culvert and rolled over, the Green County Sheriff's department reported.

**Monticello Native**

Mrs. Zwickey was a native of Monticello and had always lived in the Monticello-Albany area. She had resided in Albany for the past 30 years. The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Peter Zimmerman, she married Rudy Zwickey, who died, about 50 years ago.

Surviving are one son, Earl; four grandchildren; three step-grandchildren, and four step-great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Friday in the Sharer funeral home, Albany, with the Rev. Kyle M. Miller of the First Baptist church, officiating. Burial was in Hillcrest cemetery, Albany.
